- 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz/100g balls of Paintbox Yarns Wool Blend Worsted:
  - 3(3:3:3:4:4:4) balls in Night (A)
  - 5(5:6:6:7:7:8) balls in Rose (B)
- 5 buttons
- US 8 (5mm) crochet hook

## GAUGE (TENSION)

15 stitches and 17 rows measured over 4in/10cm of single crochet (*double crochet*), using US 8 (5mm) hook.

10.5 stitches and 16.5 rows measured over 4in/10cm of alternating single crochet spike stitch (*alternating double crochet spike stitch*), using US 8 (5mm) hook.

## GOOD TO KNOW

- Paintbox Yarns cannot accept responsibility for the finished item if any yarn other than the recommended yarn is used.
- Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
- Instructions are written using US terminology with UK terminology given in italics in round brackets ( ) afterwards.
- Repeat figures in square brackets [ ] the number of times stated afterwards.
- Instructions are given for the smallest size, with changes for the larger sizes given in round brackets ( ) afterwards.
- Where only one figure is given, this relates to all sizes.
- Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times or rows are worked for this size.

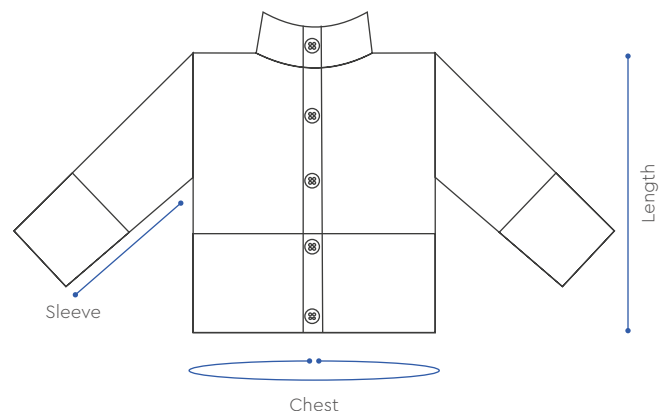

st/s stitch/es



## PATTERN STITCH

**1st row** 1 sc (*dc*), [1 SPsc (*SPdc*), 1 sc (*dc*)] to end.

**2nd row** 1 SPsc (*SPdc*), [1 sc (*dc*), 1 SPsc (*SPdc*)] to end.

These 2 rows **form** pattern and are repeated.

## BACK

Make 52(58:62:68:74:78:84) ch using US 8 (5mm) crochet hook and A.

**Set up row** 1 sc (*dc*) in second ch from hook and in each rem ch to end, turn.

| 51(57:61:67:73:77:83) sts.

**1st patt row (right side)** Ch 1 (does not count as st throughout), 1 sc (*dc*), [1 SPsc (*SPdc*), 1 sc (*dc*)] to end, turn.

**2nd patt row** Ch 1, 1 SPsc (*SPdc*) [1 sc (*dc*), 1 SPsc (*SPdc*)] to end, turn.

These 2 rows **set** patt. Cont in patt to 6¼(6¼:6¾:6¾:6¾:6¾:6¾)in/16(16:17:17:17:17:18.5)cm ending with a wrong side row.

Cut A.

Cont in patt as set with B to 19(19:19¼:19¼:19¾:19¾:20¼)in/48(48:49:49:50.5:50.5:51.5)cm ending with a wrong side row.

### Shape shoulder

**Next row** Ch 1, work 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts in patt, turn.

Work a further 2 rows in patt over these 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts only. Cut yarn and secure last st.

Skip next 15(17:17:19:21:21:23) sts, rejoin B to next st, ch 1, work 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts in patt, turn.

Work a further 2 rows in patt over these 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts only. Cut yarn and secure last st.

## LEFT FRONT

Make 30(33:35:38:41:43:46) ch using US 8 (5mm) crochet hook and A.

**Set up row** 1 sc (*dc*) in second ch from hook and in each rem ch to end, turn.

| 29(32:34:37:40:42:45) sts.

**1st patt row (right side)** Ch 1 (does not count as st throughout), 0(1:1:0:1:0:1) sc (*dc*), [1 SPsc (*SPdc*), 1 sc (*dc*)] to last 5 sts, 5 sc (*dc*), turn.

**2nd patt row** Ch 1, 5 sc (*dc*), [1 SPsc (*SPdc*), 1 sc (*dc*)] to last 0(1:1:0:1:1:0) st/s, 0(1:1:0:1:1:0) SPsc (*SPdc*), turn.

These 2 rows **set** patt. Cont in patt to 6¼(6¼:6¾:6¾:6¾:6¾:6¾)in/16(16:17:17:17:17:18.5)cm ending with a wrong side row. Cut A.

Cont in patt as set with B to 18(18:18½:18½:19:19:19½)in/46(46:47:47:48.5:48.5:49.5)cm ending with a wrong side row.

### Shape front

Keeping pattern correct continue as follows:

**Next row (right side)** Ch 1, patt across next 21(23:25:27:29:31:33) sts, turn.

**Next row** Ch 1, sc2tog (*dc2tog*), patt to end, turn.

| 20(22:24:26:28:30:32) sts.

**Next row** Ch 1, patt to end, turn.

Cont dec 1 st at neck edge every right side row as set to 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts, ending with a wrong side row.

Cut yarn and secure last st.

## RIGHT FRONT

Make 30(33:35:38:41:43:46) ch using US 8 (5mm) crochet hook and A.

**Set up row** 1 sc (*dc*) in second ch from hook and in each rem ch to end, turn.

| 29(32:34:37:40:42:45) sts.

**1st patt row (right side)** Ch 1 (does not count as st throughout), 5 sc (*dc*), [1 sc (*dc*), 1 SPsc (*SPdc*)] to last 0(1:1:0:1:1:0) sts/s, 0(1:1:0:1:1:0) sc (*dc*), turn.

**2nd patt row** Ch 1, 0(1:1:0:1:1:0) SPsc (*SPdc*), [1 sc (*dc*), 1 SPsc (*SPdc*)] to last 5 sts, 5 sc (*dc*), turn.

These 2 rows **set** patt.

Work a further 3(3:5:5:5:5:7) rows in patt.

**\*1st buttonhole row (wrong side)** Ch 1, patt to last 5 sts, 1 sc (*dc*), 2 ch, skip 2 sts, 2 sc (*dc*), turn.

**2nd buttonhole row** Ch 1, 2 sc (*dc*), 2 sc (*dc*) in ch sp, 1 sc (*dc*), patt to end, turn.

Work a further 17 rows in patt.

**1st buttonhole row (right side)** Ch 1, 2 sc (*dc*), 2 ch, skip 2 sts, 1 sc (*dc*), patt to end, turn.

**2nd buttonhole row** Ch 1, patt to last 5 sts, 1 sc (*dc*), 2 sc (*dc*) in ch sp, 2 sc (*dc*), turn.\*\* Cut A.

With B, work a further 17 rows in patt.

With B, work from \* to \*\* once more.

Work a further 6(6:6:6:8:8:8) rows in patt.

### Shape front

**Next row** Cut yarn, skip next 8(9:9:10:11:11:12) sts rejoin B to next st with 1 ch, patt to end, turn.

| 21(23:25:27:29:31:33) sts.

**Next row** Ch 1, sc2tog (*dc2tog*), patt to end, turn.

| 20(22:24:26:28:30:32) sts.

**Next row** Ch 1, patt to end, turn.

Cont dec 1 st at neck edge every right side row as set to 18(20:22:24:26:28:30) sts, ending with a wrong side row.

Cut yarn and secure last st.

## SLEEVES (MAKE 2)

Make 50(52:54:56:58:62:66) ch using US 8 (5mm) crochet hook and A.

**Set up row** 1 sc (*dc*) in second ch from hook and in each rem ch to end, turn.

| 49(51:53:55:57:61:65) sts.

**1st patt row (right side)** Ch 1 (does not count as st throughout), 1 sc (*dc*), [1 SPsc (*SPdc*), 1 sc (*dc*)] to end, turn.

**2nd patt row** Ch 1, 1 SPsc (*SPdc*) [1 sc (*dc*), 1 SPsc (*SPdc*)] to end, turn.

These 2 rows **set** patt. Cont in patt to 4(4:4¼:4¼:4¼:4¼)in/10(10:11:11:11:11)cm ending with a wrong side row. Cut A.

Cont in patt as set with B to 12½(12½:13:13:13½:13½)in/32(32:33:33:34.5:34.5:34.5)cm.

Cut yarn and secure last st.

## TO MAKE UP

Place body pieces with right sides together. Using whip stitch and A, join shoulder edges.

**Neck trim**

With right side facing, work around neck edge as follows with B: ch 1, 5 sc (*dc*) along front trim, 9(10:10:11:12:12:13) sc (*dc*) along front neck edge, 4 sc (*dc*) along side edge of back neck, 18(20:20:22:24:24:26) sc (*dc*) along back neck, 4 sc (*dc*) along side edge of back neck, 9(10:10:11:12:12:13) sc (*dc*) along front neck edge, 5 sc (*dc*) along front trim.

| 54(58:58:62:66:66:70) sts.

**Next row** Ch 1, sc (*dc*) to end.

Work a further 2(2:2:2:0:0:0) rows in sc (*dc*).

**Next row** Ch 1, 50(54:54:58:62:62:66) sc (*dc*), 2 ch, skip 2, 2 sc (*dc*).

**Next row** Ch 1, 2 sc (*dc*), 2 sc (*dc*) in ch sp, 50(54:54:58:62:62:66) sc (*dc*).

**Next row** Ch 1, sc (*dc*) to end.

Work a further 4(4:4:4:6:6:6) rows in sc (*dc*).

Cut yarn and secure last st.

Line up center top of sleeve with shoulder seam, measure 9(9½:9¾:10¼:10½:11½:12)in/23(24:25:26:27:29:30.5)cm down each of body pieces from this point, join sleeves to body between these points using whip stitch and B. Join side seams and underarm seams, matching row ends, changing color where needed. Line up buttons with buttonholes, stitch buttons in place.

Pin out cardigan to measurements given, cover with a clean damp cloth and leave to dry naturally.





### TOP TIP
